

SELWYN SAFARI 2011



Canterbury Scouts are invited to participate in the Selwyn Safari. Last year 87 Scouts and 35 Leaders took part in the Safari. The Safari covers about 20km of tramping over a weekend. Take up the challenge and join us this year in our back country adventure.

WHERE: In the Springfield / Dalethorpe / Thirteen Mile Bush / Selwyn River Gorge area. Details later.

WHEN: 3 & 4 December 2011. (Postponement date: 10 & 11 Dec).

COST: \$5.00 per Scout / Leader; includes an embroidered activity badge. Please note that the badge can only be guaranteed to those entered by the closing date of 19 November 2011.

ELIGIBILITY: Be an older Scout, i.e. at least 13 years of age as at 30 November 2011. Scouts attend as a member of an adhoc Patrol with a minimum number of 4 and a maximum number of 7. If there are insufficient Scouts for a Patrol from your Troop, then approach a neighbouring Troop.

CHECK POINTS: These will be at strategic locations.

ACHIEVEMENT: The Safari is an excellent opportunity to pass off many aspects of the Scout Award Scheme.

LEADERS: Many Leaders enjoy their annual get together on the Selwyn Safari. Leaders are most welcome to participate, provided they are willing to assist on check points if the need arises. Please note Leaders are not to accompany the Scouts in their Patrols while tramping.
